



Simplified Cub Scout Closing Flag Ceremony

Caller: "Color guard, ATTENTION!"

Caller: "Audience, please rise."

Give the audience time to rise.

Caller: "Color guard, ADVANCE."

Scouts walk forward and split off to go to each flag. They stop next to the flags, turn and face the audience at attention with arms at their sides.

Caller: "Color guard, retrieve the Colors."

The flag bearers pick up the flags from the stands.

Caller: "SCOUT SALUTE. Those not in uniform, please place your right hand over your heart."

The flag bearers pick up the flags from the stands. Those in uniform do a hand salute. Everyone else places their hand on their heart.

Caller: "Color guard, return to ranks."

The flags are carried back to the rear of the room. The scout with the U.S. flag crosses in front of the second flag to go first. The flags can be walked out in single or double file.

Caller: "TWO. Color guard, dismissed."

Everyone drops salute.
